## Novelis Wins BMW Innovation Award For Lightweight Vehicle Construction

The new doors are 25 percent lighter than a similar steel design.

Indeed, over 6,000 of these new doors are being produced daily by BMW for its latest 7 Series and 5 Series sedans as well as the 5 Series Gran Turismo.
